


Sin

- Universal (a condition of all humans)
- Inescapable
- Failure or refusal to live in right relationship



Sin is multidimensional



God's Intention - Rightness

God's intentions for humankind were for us to be a community of peace that *reflected* and *participated* in the nature of God-in-relationship.




Sin, therefore, is simply anything that breaks peace and tears the relational fabric between created beings, their God, their fellows and their environment. It is a willing rejection of God and his will for all relationships.
