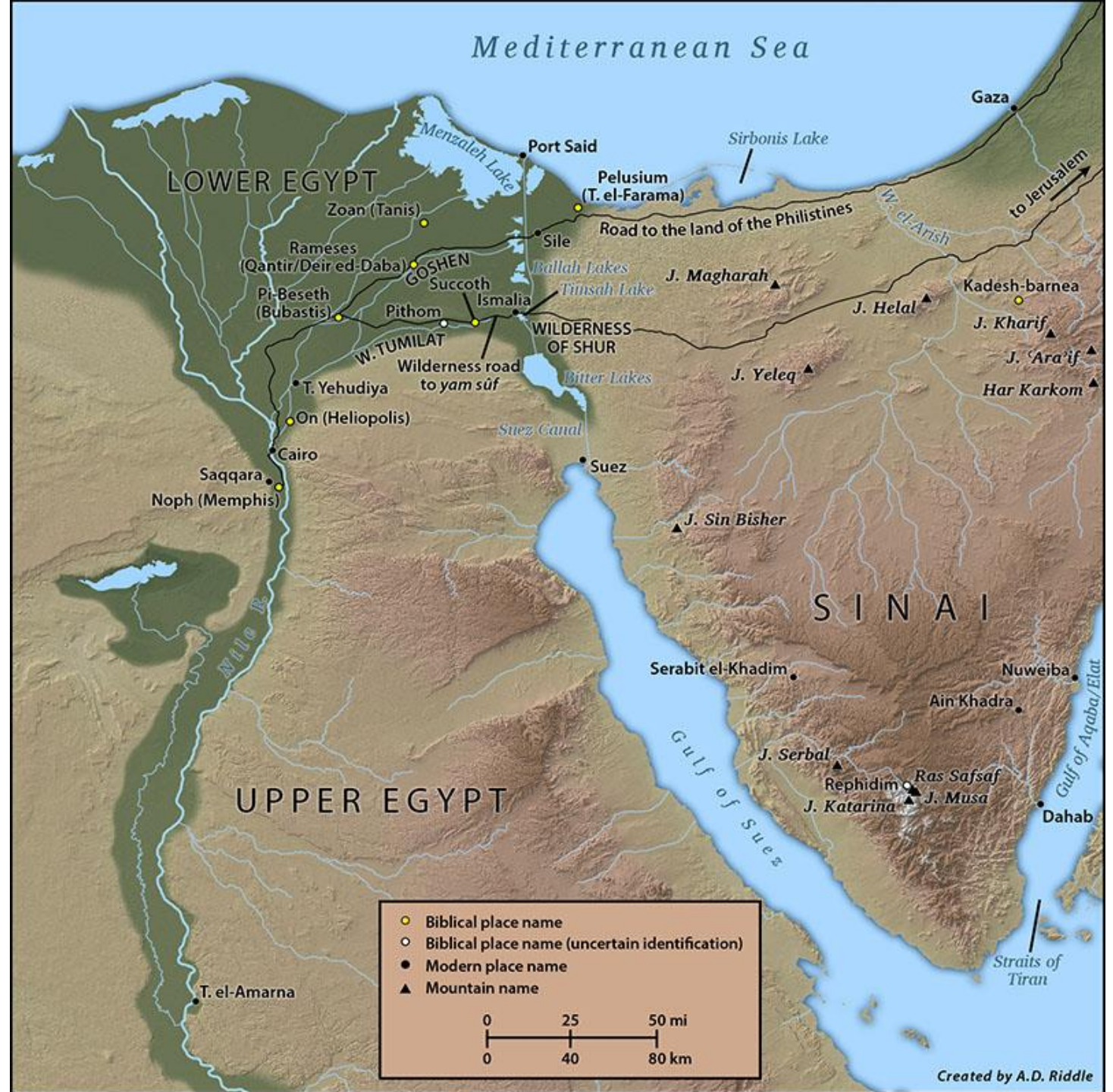

## Exodus 13:17-18 (NIV)

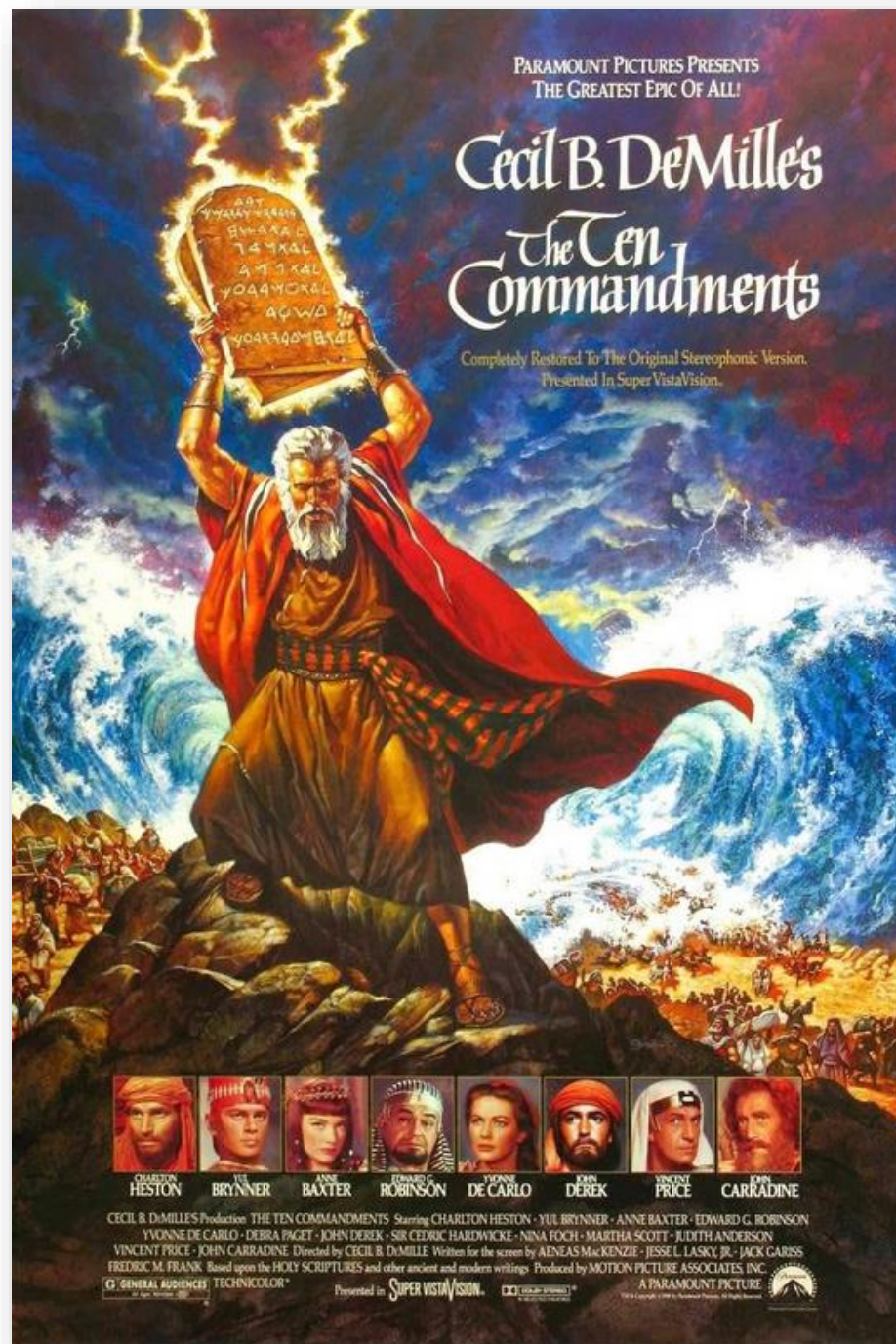

Exodus 3:19,20

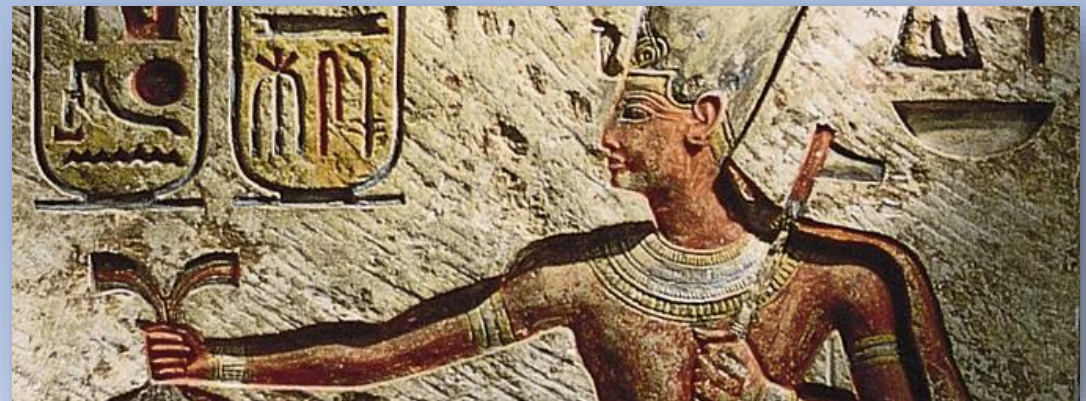
I know that the king of Egypt will not let you go unless a **mighty hand** compels him. So I will **stretch out my hand and strike the Egyptians** with all the wonders that I will perform among them. After that, he will let you go.

Exodus 6:1,6

Then the LORD said to Moses, “Now you will see what I will do to Pharaoh: Because of **my mighty hand** he will let them go; because of **my mighty hand** he will drive them out of his country.”  
... “Therefore, say to the Israelites: ‘I am the LORD, and I will bring you out from under the yoke of the Egyptians. I will free you from being slaves to them, and I will **redeem you with an outstretched arm and with mighty acts of judgment.**’”

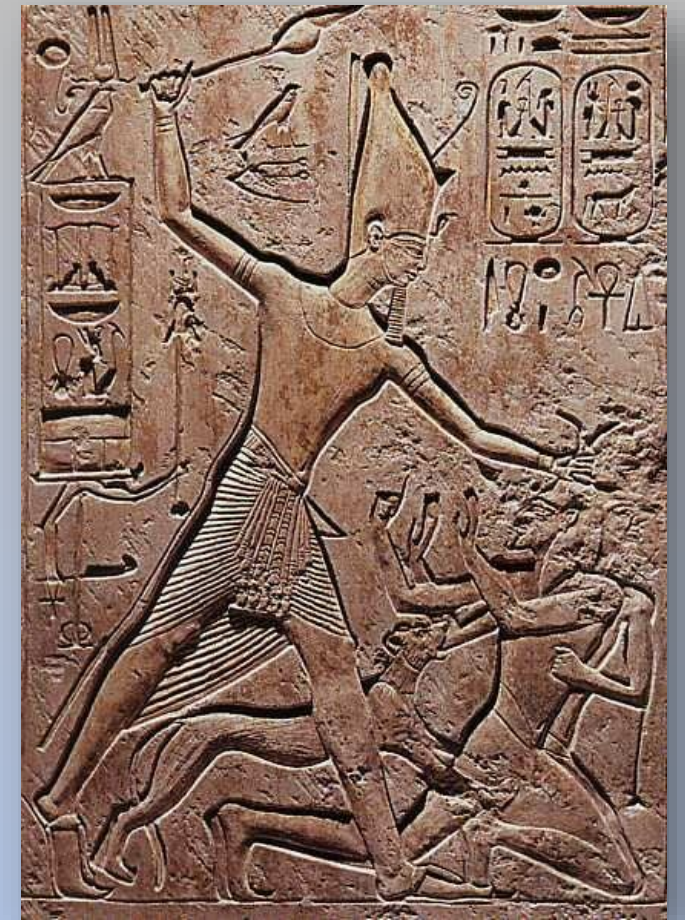
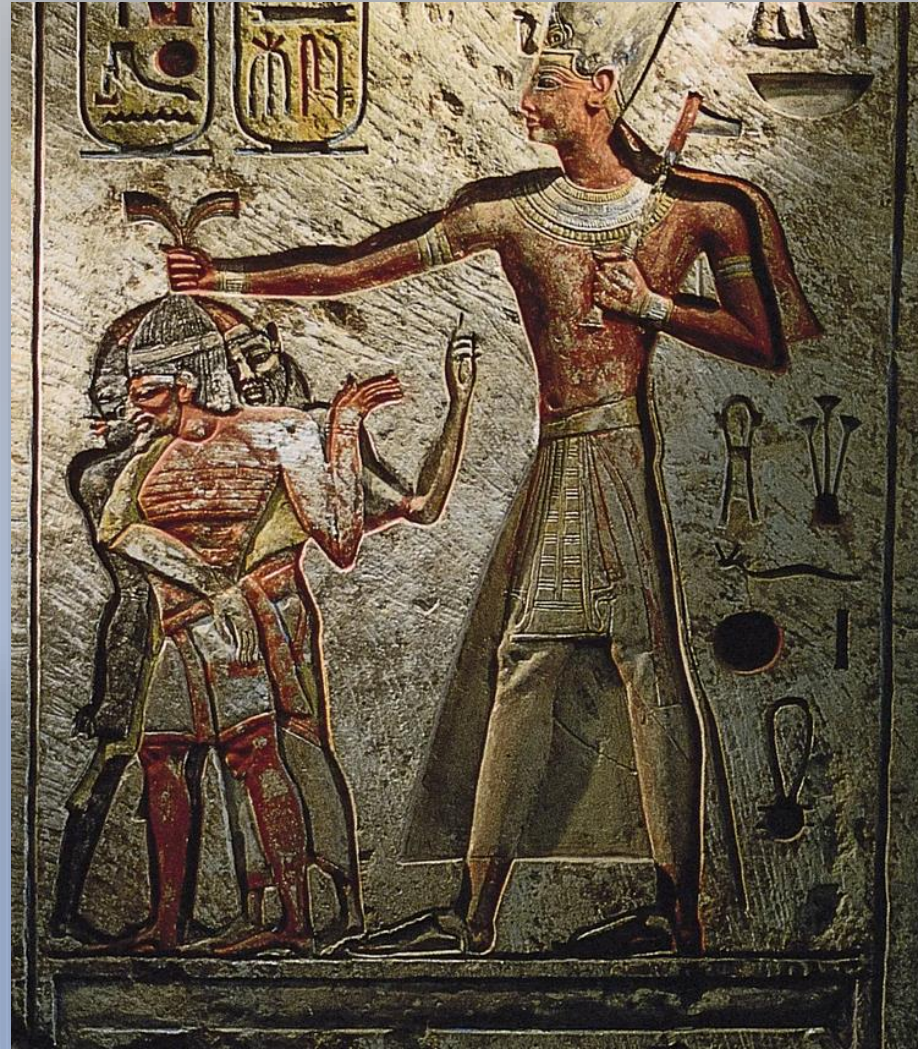
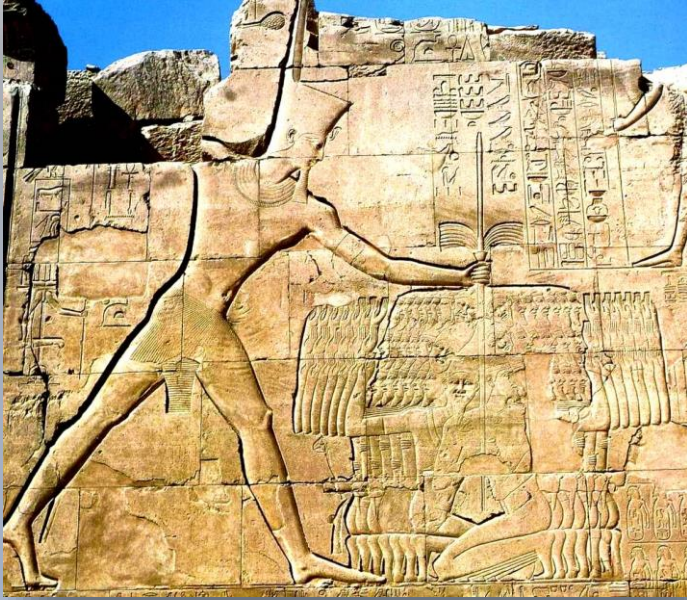
Deuteronomy 5:15

Isaiah 51:9-10

redeemed might cross over?

Jeremiah 31:31-32 “...when I **took them by the hand**  
**to lead them** out of Egypt.”

Isaiah 41: 13 For I am the LORD your God who **takes**  
**hold of your right hand** and says to you, Do not fear;  
I will help you.

Isaiah 40:10-11

See, the Sovereign LORD comes with power,

# a new exodus

## Isaiah 43:1-3

But now, this is what the LORD says—

he who **created** you, Jacob,  
he who formed you, Israel:

“Do not fear, for I have  
**redeemed** you;

I have summoned you by name;  
you are mine.

**When you pass through the  
waters, I will be with you;**  
and when you pass through the  
rivers, they will not sweep  
over you....

For I am the LORD your God, the  
Holy One of Israel, your **Savior**.





# Jesus – redeemer, saviour

**Mark 10:13,16** Jesus **took the children in his arms**, placed his hands on them and blessed them.

**Mark 9:36** He took a little child and had him stand among them. **Taking the child in his arms**, he said to them, ...

**Mark 5:41, Matt 9:25** Jesus **took the girl by the hand** and said to her '*Talitha koum*' (which means 'little girl, get up'). Immediately, she stood up...

**Mark 1:31** Jesus went to her, **took her hand** and helped her up.

**Mark 8:23** Jesus **took the blind man by the hand and led him** outside the village.

**Matthew 14:30-31** Peter, beginning to sink, cried out "Lord, save me." Immediately, Jesus **reached out his hand** and caught him.





# Jesus – redeemer, saviour

**Matthew 20:28** The Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to **give his life as a ransom** for many.”

**Ephesians 1:7** In Jesus Christ we have **redemption** through his blood, the forgiveness of sins.

**Colossians 1:13** For he has **rescued** us from the dominion of darkness and **brought us into** the kingdom of the Son he loved...

**Hebrews 2:14-15** Since the children have flesh and blood, he too shared in their humanity so that by his death he might ... **free** those who all their lives were **held in slavery** by their fear of death.

**Revelation 1:5** He has **freed** us from our sins by his blood.

**John 8:34-36** Everyone who sins is a **slave** to sin... If the Son **sets you free**, you will be **free** indeed.

**Galatians 4:5-7** God sent his Son, ... to **redeem** those under the law, ... So you are **no longer a slave**, but God’s child.
