



Micah 7

*Though I sit in darkness,

9 Because I have sinned against him,

Unified Scripture

Micah 7:9 “I will bear the Lord’s wrath, until he pleads my case and upholds my cause,”

*Compare with **Psalm 18***

*Or **Psalm 50***

*And the heavens proclaim his righteousness,
for he is a God of justice.*

*Or **Exodus***

and from mountain to mountain.*

*Who is a God like you
who pardons sin and forgives the transgression
of the remnant of his inheritance?*
